TRACKING TEST INFORMATION

TEST LIMITED TO SIX TD ENTRIES AND THREE TDX ENTRIES.

See Chapter 1, Section 12, AKC Tracking Regulations 7-1-90 for exchanges.

CLOSING DATE for this test is March 4, 2010 5:00 p.m., after which time entries cannot be accepted.

ENTRY FEE: TD= \$50.00, TDX= \$80.00 (includes the AKC recording fee) for each dog. Fees must accompany all entries. Fees must be paid in US FUNDS. Make checks or money orders payable to WENATCHEE KENNEL CLUB. Mail entries with fees to the test secretary. Only one AKC entry form will be accepted for each dog.

ENTRIES OF DOGS which have not yet passed an AKC Tracking Test must include a form certifying that the dog is considered ready for such a test. This form must be an original statement, dated within one year of the test and signed by a person who has been approved by the American Kennel Club to judge tracking tests.

ENTRIES OF DOGS in Tracking Dog Excellent Test must have passed an AKC Tracking Test.

ALL ENTRIES will be accepted until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. A drawing will be held on Thursday March 5, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. at The Wenatchee Kennel Club, 960 Valley Mall Pkway, East Wenatchee, WA. Entrants are invited to attend. The drawing shall be completely random among all entries received, except that preference will be given to those dogs that have not previously earned a TD or TDX title. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth in the preceding paragraph, shall be assigned a position on an alternate list. The alternates will be asked to be alternates who agree to be at the test site in case of absent dogs. Alternates not used will receive full refund of entry fees. WENATCHEE KENNEL CLUB will also refund entry fees to any confirmed entry that withdraws from the test, provided the Test Secretary is notified prior to the day of the test and provided that an alternate entry participates in the test as a result of the withdrawal. If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks may be exchanged up to a maximum of twelve TD's or six TDX.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS will be mailed by the Test Secretary after the closing of entries. Should the exhibitor not receive such an acknowledgment within reasonable time, please notify the Test Secretary at 509.664.1259

THIS TD/TDX TEST will open at 5 a.m. and continue until all tests are completed.

ALL DOGS must be at the TD/TDX test location parking lot by 8:00 a.m. Sunday, March 14, 2010 at which time there will be a drawing for tracks for each dog entered. The first track will be run as soon thereafter as it has aged the proper length of time. In the event of any absentee(s) among the confirmed entries, the next alternate, in catalog order, who is present, will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE, subject to the provisions set forth in the most current AKC Tracking Regulations. Please check with the secretary about where to park.

THE WENATCHEE KENNEL CLUB will exercise all reasonable care for the safety of dogs, handlers, and spectators, but neither the Club nor the Individual Property Owners will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any dog or person on the TD or TDX grounds.

DOGS THAT ARE NOT ACTUALLY COMPETING will go where instructed and ALL dogs will be kept on leash at all times.

TRACKING COVER for TD will be sagebrush and native cover, or hay fields and pasture. TDX may use all of the above plus orchards, Douglas Creek, and fences, if used, will be barbed wire.

Coffee and muffins will be furnished for exhibitors and spectators on the morning of the test. The Wenatchee Kennel Club will provide an awards luncheon, on site, following the test.

AWARDS

Wooden apple plaques are offered for all dogs passing a TD or TDX Test.

DIRECTIONS TO SITE: The Draw will take place in the parking lot of Nelson's Fruit Market, located at the intersection of Hwy 28 and the Palisades Road, halfway between East Wenatchee and Quincy.

From East Wenatchee stoplight at Grant Road and Hwy 28 (Top Foods, Fred Meyer), go east toward Quincy, 14.4 miles. Between mile marker 14 and 15 is beginning of road to Palisades.

Coming West from Quincy it is approximately 15 plus miles. Mile markers on left side of road.
