ENTRY LIMIT: TEST LIMITED TO SIX TD ENTRIES AND THREE

TDX ENTRIES. Combined Tests Exchange Policy - Chapter 1, Section 17a Test Worker Option - 3 tracks may be set aside for test workers from previous tests Chapter 1, Section 17d, AKC Tracking Regulations.

ENTRY FEE: TD- \$60.00, TDX=-\$90.00 (includes the AKC recording fee) for each dog. Fees must accompany all entries. Fees must be paid in US FUNDS. Only one AKC entry form will be accepted for each dog.

ELIGIBILITY FOR TD TEST:

Dogs eligible for TD Tracking Test must have passed a tracking certification and include a form certifying that the dog is considered ready for such a test. This form must be an original statement, dated within one year of the test and signed by a person who has been approved by the American Kennel Club to judge tracking tests.

ELIGIBILITY FOR TDX TEST:

The Tracking Dog Excellent is for dogs that have passed an AKC Tracking test.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE:

Subject to the provisions set forth in the most current AKC Tracking Regulations. Bitches in season may participate. Entrants must notify the Test Secretary prior to the drawing for tracks Please check with the secretary about where to park.

ALL ENTRIES will be accepted until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. A drawing will be held on Thursday, March 2, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at The Wenatchee Kennel Club, 960 Valley Mall Pkwy, East Wenatchee, WA. Entrants are invited to attend. The drawing shall be completely random among all entries received, except that preference will be given to those dogs that have not previously earned a TD or TDX title.

When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth above, shall be assigned a position on an alternate list. The alternates will be asked to be alternates who agree to be at the test site in case of absent dogs. Alternates not used will receive full refund of entry fees.

WENATCHEE KENNEL CLUB will also refund entry fees to any confirmed entry that withdraws from the test, provided the Test Secretary is notified prior to the day of the test and provided that an alternate entry participates in the test as a result of the withdrawal. If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks may be exchanged up to a maximum of twelve TD's or six TDX.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS:

Acknowledgments will be mailed or emailed by the Test Secretary after the closing of entries. Should the exhibitor not receive such an acknowledgment within reasonable time, please notify the Test Secretary at 509-630-7712.

TRACKING COVER:

TD will be sagebrush and native cover, or hay fields and pasture. **TDX** may use all of the above plus orchards, Douglas Creek, and fences, if used, will be barbed wire.

DRAW FOR TD and TDX TRACKS:

Draw for the running order of the TD and TDX tracks will be held on Sunday, March 12, at **8:00 AM** (Daylight Savings Time begins at 2:00AM). The first track will be run as soon when it has aged the appropriate time.

In the event of any absentees among the confirmed entries, the next alternate, in catalog order, who is present, will be allowed to fill the vacancy.



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division,
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- 5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
