Take I-90 E toward Vantage/Spokane; take exit #151/WA-283 toward N/Ephrata/Soap Lake onto WA-281-SPUR; turn right onto WA-283 toward WA-283 N/Ephrata/Soap Lake; continue on WA-28; bear left onto WA-17 (toward Soap Lake & Coulee City); turn right onto US-2 toward Coulee City; continue on US-2 for approximately 22.5 miles until 2.3 miles east of Almira; turn left (north) onto Corbett Draw Road North; travel approximately 1.7 miles; then turn right onto graveled ranch driveway; travel approximately ½ mile past home on left until you arrive at the ranch storage buildings and equipment yard; follow signs to parking for the Hunt Tests grounds.
